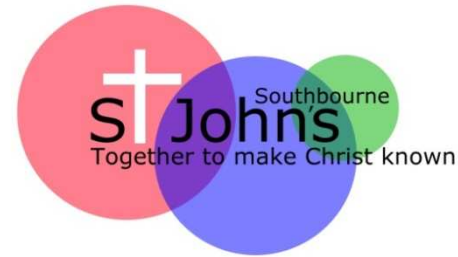
An Audience with Simon Brett - Thurs. 18th March 7.30pm
